**AN ORDINANCE TO SUPPLEMENT THE APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 FOR THE CITY OF
GEORGETOWN, ILLINOIS (Second SUPPLEMENTAL)**

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-085

WHEREAS, The City of Georgetown, adopted Ordinance Number 2019-050, Annual Appropriations Ordinance on April 15, 2019.

WHEREAS, Illinois Compiled Statutes, Chapter 65, Section 5/8-2-7 and 9, allows the City at any time after passage, by 2/3 vote of the Corporate Authorities, to make transfers within any department or other separate agency of the Municipal Government, of sums of money appropriated for one corporate object or purpose to another corporate object or purpose provided any transfer not be reduced below an amount sufficient to cover all obligations incurred or to be incurred against that appropriation; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to move monies at this time, and the corporate authorities desire to make the transfers within the General Funds of the City of sums of money appropriated for one corporate object or purpose to another corporate object or purpose,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the below listed Appropriations in the Annual Appropriation Ordinance of the City of Georgetown in the County of Vermillion in the State of Illinois for Fiscal Year beginning on May 1, 2019 and ending on April 30, 2020, commonly known as City of Georgetown Ordinance No. 2019-050 is hereby further amended as follows: Additionally, the City Council approves of the new appropriation amounts to be used as budget amounts for this Line Item amended.

A, Business District – Line Items

- a. Building/Ground Beautification shall be increased by \$2,020 from \$0 to \$2,020
- b. Capital Outlay Land shall increase by \$380 from \$0 to \$380
- c. Grants – Local Business expenditures shall increase by \$5,000 from \$0 to \$5,000

B. Municipal Debt Service Fund – Line Items

- a. 2004 Debt/Fees expenditures shall be increased by \$750 from \$0 to \$750

Section 2. That all other provisions of City of Georgetown Ordinance Numbers 2019-050, shall remain in full force and effect without change.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the City Council of trustees, its approval by the City Mayor, and its publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed insofar as they conflict.

Section 5. If any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, and this City Council hereby expressly declares that it would have enacted this Ordinance even with the invalid portion deleted.
