
I, Jacqueline Wilson, certify that I am duly appointed and acting municipal clerk of the City of Georgetown, Vermilion County, Illinois.

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-141

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF LABOR PREVAILING WAGE
DETERMINATION

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An ACT regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being Chapter 820 ILCS 130/1-12, Illinois Compiled Statutes; and Whereas, the aforesaid Act requires that the City of Georgetown, Illinois to investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said City of Georgetown employed in performing construction of public works, for said City of Georgetown;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Vermilion County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works" approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the City of Georgetown is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Vermilion County, Illinois area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 2017, (most recent available update) a copy of that determination being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works of this City of Georgetown to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3. The Clerk of the City of Georgetown shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the City of Georgetown this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

SECTION 4. The Clerk of the City of Georgetown shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination

stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.


SECTION 5. The Clerk of the City of Georgetown shall promptly file or cause to be filed a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6. The Clerk of the City of Georgetown shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area that the determination of prevailing wages has been made. Said notice shall inform the public that the prevailing wage rates have been updated, that the City of Georgetown has passed and approved this ordinance and that a complete copy of the Illinois Department of Labor determination establishing such updated rates is available for public inspection at the Georgetown City Hall. Such publication shall constitute notice that this is the determination of the City of Georgetown and is effective.

SECTION 7. The Clerk of the City of Georgetown is empowered to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.


