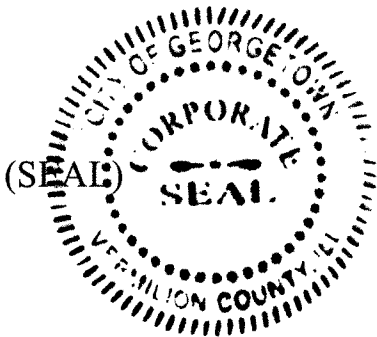

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10: VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

**WHEREAS** the City of Georgetown, Illinois, a municipal corporation, acting through its corporate authorities, is tasked with maintaining the safe and orderly flow of motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

**WHEREAS** the City of Georgetown, in order to maintain the safe and orderly flow of motor vehicle traffic, has the authority to establish rules regarding vehicles stopping and standing upon public streets and alleys within the municipality.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Georgetown, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** This ordinance amends Title 10, Chapter 20, Subsection 10.20.130, and to the extent that said chapter or any portion thereof are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, the same are hereby repealed.

**Section 2.** Subsection 10.20.130 is hereby deleted, and replaced in its entirety by the following language:

"No parking shall be permitted on East West Street between the hours of 8am and 5pm, every day. After 5pm each day, one (1) parking spot shall be available on the North side and two (2) parking spots shall be available on the South side of the first block."

**Section 3.** The city shall erect appropriate no parking signs in accordance with this amendment.

**Section 4.** The City Clerk is empowered to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**Section 5.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication, or as soon thereafter as allowed by law.




